Cyber Awareness Training Being Offered To The Public

Internet safety and examples of real-life cyber attacks will be discussed at workshop during National Cybersecurity Awareness Month.

Indianapolis, IN, September 30, 2019 – SecOps Cyber Institute™ and The Homeland Security Bureau in conjunction with the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 10003 in Carmel, IN will conduct a cyber awareness workshop, free for the public, at the Carmel VFW on October 24 from 7-9 PM.

This workshop will give tips on how people can be safer as they use the Internet and how not to fall victim to its many traps and pitfalls. Examples of several recently declassified cyber attacks will be reviewed and the dark underbelly of the Internet where there are no rules, no laws, and where organized crime and gangs meet to do business will be discussed. Attendees will also learn about some of the specialized training that the Homeland Security team has been through and what training is available to the public.

“National Cybersecurity Awareness Month was the perfect time to hold this workshop,” said Jeremy Miller, CEO of SecOps Cyber Institute. He continued, “Terms like phishing, pharming, ransomware and spoofing are commonly heard on the news almost every night. This workshop will define threats like these and help people understand what their options are if and when their computer systems are compromised.”
